Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 28(j) and Circuit Rule 28(f), Plaintiffs-Appellants submit this supplemental authority regarding *Salazar v. Buono*, No. 08-472, 559 U. S. ____ (April 28, 2010).

A fair amount of the discussion in *Salazar* was spent on the standing question currently before this Court in the instant case. Justice Kennedy's plurality opinion made it clear that, whatever the merits of the case, "[t]he standing inquiry, by contrast, turns on the alleged injury that prompted the plaintiff to invoke the court's jurisdiction in the first place." Slip op. at 8. In other words, the courts are not to confuse "an argument about standing [with an argument] about the merits." *Id.* at 9.

In the instant case, Plaintiffs personally confronted both the Chief Justice's addition of "so help me God," and the clergy's prayers. AOB 15 *et seq*. Whether

that phrase and those prayers violate the Establishment Clause is an issue that can be determined after Plaintiffs have had an opportunity to present their evidence in the District Court. That they have standing to present that evidence, however, is unquestionable.

"[T]he alleged injury that prompted the plaintiff[s] to invoke the court's jurisdiction in the first place," is the unwanted personal confrontations with the verbiage at issue at the 2009 and at the future presidential inaugurals. *See, e.g.*, Appendix at 124-140 (providing multiple examples of plaintiffs' declarations, subscribed and sworn to under penalty of perjury).
